## Competition Format

### Regional Challenge Cup Series

- Qualification (Compulsory Round 1 and Compulsory Round 2)
- FIG rules will apply for the qualification round other than:
  - Gymnasts who do not demonstrate the minimum difficulty performance standard or compete 4 complete exercises will not be eligible to qualify for the Regional Challenge Cup Championships but may be awarded a medal at the Region's discretion.

### Regional Challenge Cup Championships

- Qualification (Compulsory Round 1 and Compulsory Round 2)
- FIG rules will apply

## Qualification to the Inter-Regional Challenge Cup Final

A maximum of 1 gymnast per age group, per gender will qualify to the Inter-Regional Challenge Cup Final made up of the following:

- Places will be allocated in rank order from the Regional Challenge Cup Series events (max 3).
- In the event of a tied position the tie break rule will apply (see below)
- All Regions must submit the list of the gymnasts that have qualified to BG

Tie Break:

- (1) The gymnast with the higher total E-score prevails
- (2) If there is still a tie, the gymnast with the higher E-score from the final two exercises prevails

Entry to the Inter-Regional Challenge Cup Final must be completed by Regions via British Gymnastics' GymNET online Entry Portal by the published closing date.

Where skills are indicated in red, gymnasts can choose to use a mount or a spotter skill but must still ensure that the same skill is not used in the same place in another pass, otherwise the DD for the repeated element will not be awarded. All 4 exercises must remain different.

## **Competition Format**

### **Spring Cups & National Age Group Final**

- Cat 1 Men/Women
- Cat 2 Men/Women
- All Gymnasts will compete 4 exercises. The score will be cumulative
- FIG rules will apply other than:
  - Gymnasts who do not demonstrate the minimum difficulty performance standard will:
    - Not be awarded a medal
    - Not be eligible to qualify for the National Age Group Final

### **Qualification to the National Age Group Final**

A maximum number of 8 gymnasts per category, age group, gender will be invited to attend the National Age Group Final.

The final list of qualifiers for the National Age Group Final will be published on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2022.

Entry to the NAGF must be completed by clubs via British Gymnastics' GymNET online Entry Portal by the published closing date
